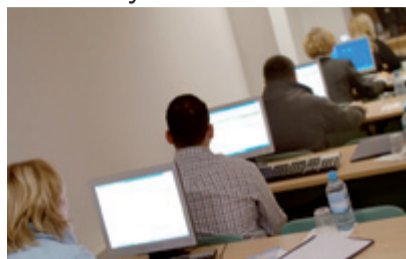
April 2009 – Welcome to our REAP Report
